Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR) August 2019 Passenger Counts

Myrtle Beach, SC, September 20, 2019 During August 2019, a total of 345,989 passengers passed through the Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR).

At MYR, total passenger traffic during August 2019, which includes enplanements and deplanements, totaled 345,989 compared to 346,647 in August 2018. The number of people arriving on flights, or deplanements, was 170,777 compared to 170,733 in 2018.

“Year-to-date, over 1.9 million passengers have passed through the Myrtle Beach International Airport” said Scott Van Moppes, director of airports. “During the first eight months of the year, the Airport is trending almost four percent above last year’s record breaking passenger counts, despite the month of August being basically flat compared to last year. However, while August counts did not come as a surprise we were not expecting American, Delta and United to report record breaking passenger volumes for the month. The strength of MYR is being propelled by a strong airline industry and due to demand generated by Myrtle Beach and the entire Grand Strand.”
