Horry County Department of Airports Thanksgiving Travel at the Myrtle Beach International Airport

Myrtle Beach, SC, November 19, 2018 – Horry County Department of Airports expects increased passenger counts at the Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR), as Thanksgiving Day approaches.

This Thanksgiving holiday, based on arriving and departing airline flight schedules, seat counts are up seven percent over last year, for approximately 47,000 total seats, at MYR (based on the four days prior/after and including Thanksgiving Day). It is anticipated that the busiest travel day at the Airport will be the day immediately before Thanksgiving, as seats counts are scheduled to be up 20% over same day last year.
