Horry County Department of Airports Frontier to Resume Nonstop Air Service to Denver, Trenton and Islip

Myrtle Beach, SC, December 6, 2018 – Frontier Airlines will resume its seasonal nonstop flight operations, at the Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR) to Denver, Trenton and Long Island.

Frontier Airlines introduced flight operations at the Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR) on May 20, 2018. Based on the airlines published schedules, available for sale, it will resume its seasonal MYR service on April 4, 2019, to Long Island MacArthur Airport (ISP) and Trenton-Mercer Airport (TTN) while service to Denver International Airport (DEN) will resume on June 11, 2019.
