Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR) Winter Holiday Travel

Myrtle Beach, SC, December 19, 2019 During the holiday travel season, airlines have scheduled a total of 70,410 arriving/departing seats at the Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR).

At MYR, during the winter holiday season, which runs from Thursday, December 19, through Sunday, January 5, airlines have scheduled 70,410 total seats. The number of scheduled departing seats is 35,205.

Based on arriving and departing seats, the lightest travel days during the winter holiday season, at the Myrtle Beach International Airport, are scheduled to be Sunday, December 22; Tuesday, December 24; Tuesday, December 31; and Thursday, January 2.

- Practice patience as Airlines for America (A4A), the industry trade organization for the leading U.S. airlines, has projected that 47.5 million passengers will fly globally on U.S. airlines over the 18-day winter holiday travel period from Thursday, December 19, through Sunday, January 5.

- Arrive at the airport two-hours prior the scheduled departure time.
