 Allegiant Announces 3-New Markets at MYR**

Myrtle Beach, SC, February 28, 2017 – Today, Allegiant announced new nonstop service from MidAmerican St. Louis Airport (BLV), Portsmouth International Airport (PSM), and Dayton International Airport (DAY) to Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR).

The new seasonal nonstop air service will commence and operate:

MidAmerican St. Louis Airport (BLV)	May 26, 2017	2x weekly
Portsmouth International Airport (PSM)	June 1, 2017	2x weekly

“Allegiant’s announcement is exciting news for Myrtle Beach International Airport,” said Scott Van Moppes, director of airports for Horry County. “Since 2012, Allegiant has been strategically introducing new nonstop air service into our market. With today’s announcement of Portsmouth, St. Louis and Dayton, and Cleveland earlier this year, the carrier now offers nonstop air service from 17-market to Myrtle Beach, SC.”
