

## 2017 Capacity Trends




- MYR now has nonstop air service to/from 38-markets

# Myrtle Beach, SC has nonstop air service from 38-markets\* on 7-carriers... more than any area airport in the region












# Spirit is the dominant carrier at MYR, while Allegiant is adding capacity at a faster rate than any other airline at the Airport


- Single largest day is July 1 with 6,993 directional seats

- 2017 Largest year-over-year increase are Wednesday and Monday


