## Horry County Department of Airports American Airlines Announces Daily Service to Washington, DC

Myrtle Beach, SC October 30, 2017 – American Airlines (AA) will expand its current weekend only nonstop air service from Reagan National Airport (DCA) to Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR) to daily nonstop air service in 2018.

The new daily nonstop air service will commence on Tuesday, April 3, 2018. American Airlines will operate the service, seven-days per week on-board E-175 aircraft:
