MYR July 2019 Passenger Counts Break Record

Myrtle Beach, SC, August 14, 2019 During July 2019, a total of 367,620 passengers passed through the Myrtle Beach International Airport (MYR), an increase of 2.9-percent compared to July 2018.

At MYR, total passenger traffic during July 2019, which includes enplanements and deplanements, totaled 367,620 compared to 357,223 in July 2018. The number of people arriving on flights, or deplanements, was 185,485 compared to 178,559 in 2018.

“During the month of July more passengers passed through the Myrtle Beach International Airport than ever before” said Scott Van Moppes, director of airports. “While all of our airline partners contributed to the record-breaking month, it was the growth by Allegiant, American, Frontier and United that pushed passenger counts over the top at MYR. We continue to be extremely grateful to our nine airline partners, operating at the Airport, for their continued investment and commitment to our market, realizing the strength of destination and demand of the traveling public for convenient air service in and out of the Grand Strand.”
